Blackboard Learn October 2015 Release	Workaround: After recording the video, click continue, this will save it in youtube.com Log into youtube.com, click on the video you have just recorded. Copy the url Go back to the editor on Bb environment Click on Insert/Edit Embedded media Paste the url into the File/URL Change Type to Embedded Audio Click Insert Click Submit
